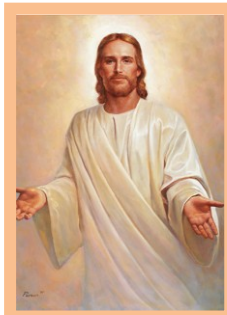

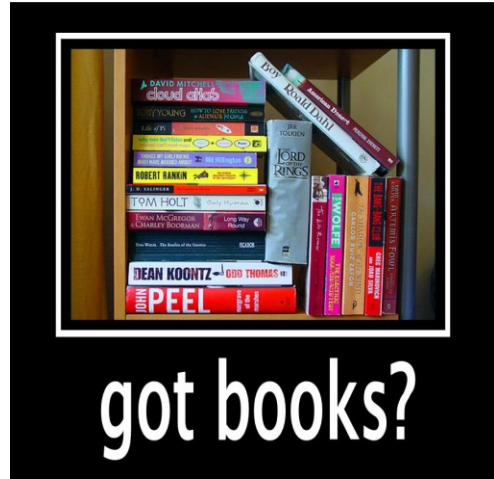
Diocesan Prayer for Vocations
