VIRTUS TRAINING:

If you are considering volunteering at Christ the King in any capacity, you must first take the VIRTUS TRAINING course.

As a reminder, under Georgia State law, every person aged 18 or older who volunteers or works for a parish or school is a mandatory reporter. **VIRTUS training, acknowledgement of the Code of Conduct and completion of a background check are required before ministry begins.**



We will also be continuing our once a month family luncheons after Mass. This gives all our children and parents an opportunity to share and fellowship with one another in a casual setting.




