FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for St. Columbkille School for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by March 15, 2021. Applicants can apply online by clicking the FACTS link at www.stcolumbkilleschool.org. Once an online application has been completed, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the application process:

- Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
- Copies of your 2020 W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

All supporting documentation can be uploaded in pdf format online.

*****Requirements for Participating Parishioner Rate:**

- School/Parish Volunteer Participation: Each family is required to generously participate and volunteer their time in at least one major event each year (with the school, PTU, athletic boosters, or parish).
- Parish/School Raffle: All families are expected to sell or purchase at least ten raffle tickets (totaling \$100/year).
- A participating parishioner refers to Catholic families who have officially registered in the Parish and demonstrate their participation through regular Mass attendance and financial support of the Parish using envelopes or Faith Direct online giving. (We suggest families contribute a minimum of \$500 per year)

TUITION RATE

Please note that it costs St. Columbkille Catholic School more than \$6,000 to educate each student at current enrollment levels. The Parish covers the substantial financial difference between per student cost and the actual tuition through its weekly offertory collection and otherwise through the generosity of those associated with the Parish.

SCHOLARSHIPS

St. Columbkille Catholic School offers several scholarship opportunities that may be available to help offset the cost of educating your child.

1. Diocesan needs-based financial assistance:

DTA is awarded annually. Applications for the 2021-2022 academic year are accepted from January - June 1, 2021. Funds are awarded in two rounds: The round one deadline is March 15, the round two deadline is June 1, 2021. Please visit <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid> to apply.

2. State of Ohio EdChoice Scholarship (Traditional or Expansion)

The Educational Choice Scholarship (EdChoice) Program provides students from designated public schools the opportunity to attend participating private schools.
