ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

This Sunday, we celebrate the feast of the Ascension, when Jesus ascended into Heaven. For forty days,

Jesus stayed with the apostles and continued to teach and guide them for what was to come; he prepared them for their missions of evangelization and the crosses that they would bear, including suffering and dying for the faith.



As we remember Jesus' Ascension, let us begin to look forward to the feast of the Pentecost, which is just ten days after the feast of the Ascension, and is regarded as the birthday of the Church. On the feast of the Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and filled them with the graces and strengths needed to make them strong soldiers for Christ. This happens to us, in the sacrament of Confirmation, when we receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, which strengthen us and fortifies the three theological gifts that we already received in the sacrament of Baptism.
