DIACONATE ORDINATION

Because of the stringent travel restrictions abroad for visitors, the Administration of the North American College in Rome advised that those men who planned to be ordained Deacons this Fall in Rome, to seek ordination in their home dioceses before returning to complete their Fourth Theology year. As a result, one of our diocesan seminarians, Nick Vetter, was ordained a Deacon on Saturday, August 15th, at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit. He will be returning to Rome shortly for his last year there. Please keep him in your prayers, along with his three classmates Jacob Degele, Ben Franchuk and Greg Hilzendegeer (already ordained deacons), as they enter their final year of seminary in anticipation of ordination to the Priesthood next June.
