CHI HEALTH AT HOME

As we experience these times of COVID-19 and are mostly quarantined to our homes, you may find yourself considering how you are spending your time. Our agency is always in great need of volunteers to assist us. Some of the areas that we need of assistance with are:

- ◆ Flower Delivery Volunteer—deliver flower to patients
- ◆ Tuck-In Volunteer—weekly phone contact to caregivers of hospice patients
- ◆ Visiting Volunteer—visiting patients and families and providing support
- ◆ Respite Volunteer—giving families a much-needed break to run errands, etc.

We do know that most of these volunteer activities are not possible at this time, however, the training could be completed now so volunteers can be completely ready to go when our city opens again.
