FROM MSGR. GENE

As I mentioned at last weekend's Masses, Bishop Kagan has appointed **Deacon Harvey Hanel** to serve our parishes. His assignment begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17th. He previously served as one of the deacons at St. Mary's Church (now known as the Pro-Cathedral) in Bismarck since 2007. It was a pleasure to work with him – and his wife Meg – during my time as pastor there, and I look forward to working with them again. Please welcome them warmly as they begin their time with us.

We have received more news from Bishop Kagan this week as well. Beginning the First Sunday of Lent (February 21st), he is reestablishing the Sunday obligation for our Diocese. After hearing from the Presbyteral Council and seeing the progress we have made throughout our State in regard to the pandemic, he believed it was time for him to do this. There will be more "changes" that will also go into effect about that time – I will communicate those to you next week, (or sooner!). These next couple weekends I will want to spend some time in my homilies reflecting on the importance of Sunday and the Eucharist, (among other things!). I know we will need to continue to be vigilant, smart, and safe in our practices and need to care for one another. But, as Pope St. John Paul II wrote, we also need to "**Rediscover Sunday: Do not be afraid to give your time to Christ! Yes, let us open our time to Christ, that we may cast light upon it and give it direction...Time given to Christ is never time lost, but is rather time gained, so that our relationships and indeed our whole life may become more profoundly human.**" Stay tuned!
