

Minutes of the CCW General Meeting November 11, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

Old Business:

Money - Linda: Linda reminded the members how to charge supplies to the CCW account and bring the receipt and report it to the office. She also reminded us that some donations have not yet been made this year. Clara moved and LaVada seconded that we donate 500 to First Choice, 500 to the LC Food Shelf and 300 to Sharing and Caring. Motion carried. Linda and Rachel will speak to Father about future donations to the Parish projects and report back in December.

Edge Dinners – Rachel: Rachel asked if she could purchase some small cookware for use for the dinners and for future needs in the kitchen. Jen moved and Clara seconded that she make the purchase. Motion carried. Related to the serving of dinners to the students there was discussion about having parents involved in the service. Rachel will review and make recommendations as to how we should proceed.

New Business:

Christmas Bazaar: It will be held on Saturday Dec. 7th from 8 until noon. Rachel reported that as of now we have 7 vendors attending. She will check with others to see if they are interested again this year. Marilyn, Mary Evers, and LaVada will chair the Cookie Walk and Pat and Sharon will be in charge of the Kitchen. We will serve coffee, and coffee cake. We will have a Cookie Walk, Breakfast, Used Items, Bake Sale, Silent Auction and Bucket Raffle. The Mission Sewing will also have their display. The sale will be handled with one cashier so colored slips will be given. Set up will be Friday. Signup sheets will be displayed starting this week end.

Other:

New Decorations: LaVada requested that we purchase additional trees for the outside display. Ann moved and Marilyn seconded to purchase the trees. Motion carried. A Nativity may also be displayed this year.

Kitchen/Funeral Committee: Pat reported that she has contacted Mary Evers, Terri Pepin and Ann Braun to learn the procedures for serving at funerals.

Adjourn: Jen moved and Rita seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried and meeting was adjourned at 8:03 p.m.
