

Minutes of the CCW General Meeting April 08, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Kathie read the minutes of the March 11, 2019 meeting. Minutes were approved as read with minor corrections.

Treasurer's Report: Linda presented the treasurer's report. Report was approved as presented. There was a donation for 400.00 for Care Packages for former students, 500.00 to the local Food Shelf, 599.80 for 10 additional tables for the dining room, and 25.98 for tablecloths for funerals. We received \$1000.00 from funerals for the past month, and 600.00 from the Christmas bazaar.

Old Business:

Freiermuth Benefit Bake sale: The bake sale earned \$705.00, and the KC's donated \$2,000.00 from the dinner and from the balance of the Valentine's Dinner.

Table Purchase: Ten 8 ft. tables have been purchased for use in the dining room or wherever they are needed. The cost was \$599.80.

Nominations: Ruth urged members to consider holding an office. President/Co president and Secretary positions are open. Linda volunteered to remain the Treasurer. Discussion followed about if no volunteers come forward, a rotation of the officer duties among the members is a possibility.

Senior Baccalaureate: The event will be Mass on Sunday May 19th at the 10:00 a.m. Breakfast will follow for the guests of honor and parents as well as the congregation. Final information will be available at the next meeting. Volunteers signed up to help on Saturday and Sunday.

Senior Scholarships: Letters will be sent to the seniors. The final decision will be made by a committee and will be announced at the breakfast. The KC's will also award a scholarship at the breakfast.

New Business:

Request for Faith Formation 2019/20: Rachel explained her concern about students coming directly from sports practice and not having anything to eat before the new Youth Ministry class. This would involve 6-7-8 grade students. It was suggested that she bring some possible

costs to the next meeting. Motion was made by Barb and seconded by Nancy that we cover some to the cost for feeding the students. Motion carried.

Holy Thursday Service: Father Wilmot has asked for 4 volunteers to participate in the service and have their feet washed. Linda, Mary Jean, Mary and Eileen volunteered.

Other:

Donation to the Parish: Discussion followed about a donation to the parish since we would not be holding a garage sale this spring. Teri moved that we donate \$6,000.00 to the parish. It was seconded by Pat. Motion carried.

Request for a Benefit: Discussion followed about what should be done if we were approached to sponsor a benefit. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that all requests should be referred to Father. Each family should be responsible for the benefit and we could possibly help in some way.

Meeting ended with a prayer lead by Ruth. Motion by Pat and seconded by Mary to adjourn. Motion carried.
