Rachel will also check into prices and examples for our next meeting. A Bible Study program was also suggested. Pat moved and LaVada seconded that we pay for the supplies. This program will start during Lent and be promoted in the church bulletin. Motion carried.

Upcoming Events: Rachel announced that it is the CCW's turn to cover the food for the Bloodmobile that will be in Lake City at the Methodist Church in January. Linda volunteered to take care of this. Kathie, later offered to help her. We will serve lunch on Tuesday January 28th. The Garage Sale will be April 29th through May 2, and the Senior Mass and Breakfast will be Sunday May 17th.

Resignation/Retirement: Pat Vaplon announced that she is retiring as the Funeral Kitchen Coordinator. She is willing to help but will turn the duties over to Teri Pepin, Mary Evers and Ann Braun. New Coffee Servers: Rachel is investigating purchasing new servers that will actually keep the coffee hot. Information will be presented at our next meeting.
