

Minutes of the CCW Meeting August 10th, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Old Business:

New Business:

Fall Festival:

Rachel reported that everything but the raffle has been cancelled. It was suggested that we consider selling tickets during the garage sale since you don't need to be present to win.

The Knights also wanted to know what we planned to do with our share of the profits so that they could put together a letter. After discussion, Mary Evers made a motion to have proceeds go directly to the church. Mary Jean seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Garage Sale:

Rachel discussed and presented the regulations that we would need to follow during the garage sale, such as following social distancing, mask wearing, and making sanitizer available. Gloves will also be made available to workers if they want to use them.

We will need to spread out this year which shouldn't be difficult since no food will be sold. However, it was suggested to possibly having bottled water for sale. It was also discussed about possibly putting big items up on top in the gathering space to leave more room in the Hall for clothing and smaller items.

It is recommended to have a separate entrance and exit if possible. It was suggested to have people come in the back doors by the office and leave by the side doors in the hall. It was also suggested to have doors open so that we don't have to sanitize as often.

Rachel brought to our attention that right now we have September 7th as drop off day and that is Labor Day so no one would be into the office to make sure if big items are brought in, it has a name and phone # on it. We are going to amend the note in the bulletin to allow people to start bringing items in on the 31st of August.

Rachel also made us aware that Father informed her that the wedding on that Saturday is thinking of moving it to Friday night instead. Father asked us to move the closing time of the sale to 4 PM instead of 5. That would also give us the option of being open on Saturday morning. After discussion, it was decided to keep the original time frame.

Judy Mishke suggested doing the \$3 fill bags at the end of each day to help get rid of things. It was decided to do the bags Thursday from 6-8 PM and Friday from noon until 4.

The decision to clean up on Friday or wait till Saturday morning was tabled until next meeting.

There will be another meeting on August 31st at 7 PM to make final plans and make sure everyone is on the same page since this is our 1st big event since the Coronavirus.

Mary Jean made a motion to adjourn, seconded by LaVada. Motion carried. Meeting ended at 7:40 PM.
