PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Spiritual desolation is a common thing that afflicts us all at different times and so it is very important to understand what it is and what to do. St. Ignatius of Loyola wrote the 14 rules of spiritual discernment. Fr. Timothy Gallagher wrote a great book on these 14 rules called "The Discernment of Spirits," which we sell at the parish office. Here is St. Ignatius' definition of spiritual desolation:

"Fourth Rule. The fourth is of spiritual desolation. I call desolation all the contrary of the third rule, such as darkness of soul, disturbance in it, movement to low and earthly things, disquiet from various agitations and temptations, moving to a lack of confidence, without hope, without love, finding oneself totally slothful, tepid, sad and, as if separated from one's Creator and Lord. For just as consolation is contrary to desolation, in the same way the thoughts that come from consolation are contrary to the thoughts come from desolation."

Do you ever feel this way? Chances are you are in spiritual desolation. Spiritual desolation is an attack from the devil who is trying to discourage us and lead us away from God. Many times people just think they are going through emotional sadness when in fact they are being assaulted by the devil. So what do we do? We need to study Fr. Gallagher's book and learn the rules so that we can grow in our spiritual life and defend ourselves from these attacks. St. Ignatius' rules are a great treasure for all of us to benefit from. 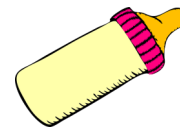
Mass on All Saints Day is at 9:00 AM.

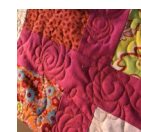

 We will meet on Tuesday, November 9th, 9:30 AM to tie quilts. A short meeting will be held around noon.



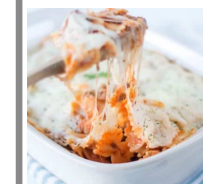
