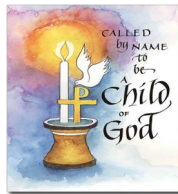

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name? Did we not drive out demons in your name?' Then I will declare to them solemnly, 'I never knew you. Depart from me, you evildoers.'" Mt 7:21-23

In the scripture above Jesus will not let those who do not know Him enter the kingdom of heaven, "I never knew you, Depart from me." It is important to ask ourselves if we know Jesus and if He knows us. Jesus is God, how can He not know us? In scripture, knowing refers to a deep and intimate friendship and relationship. God knows all people, but He does not know some people as His close friends because they choose to isolate from Him. Some people know information about Jesus but they do not know Him personally.

Jesus says, "If you love me you will keep my commandments." Jn 14:15. He tells us that if we want to achieve a personal friendship with God the Father we need to follow the commandments, pray every day, receive His grace through the sacraments and take care of the poor, the sick and the imprisoned. Serving: Coffee Cake and Beverage.

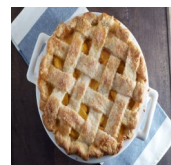
We are asking for Decorated Christmas Cookies for the Cookie Walk. These cookies are a hot item so consider making a lot.
