**PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

*"On the last and greatest day of the feast, Jesus stood up and exclaimed, "Let anyone who thirsts come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as scripture says: 'Rivers of living water will flow from within him.'" He said this in reference to the Spirit that those who came to believe in him were to receive. There was, of course, no Spirit yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified." Jn 7:37-39*

How often do you pray to the Holy Spirit? It is a good question to think about today on the Feast of Pentecost. It is very important to pray to the Holy Spirit and ask him to enter into our hearts and fill us with his love and guidance so that we can seek to carry out God the Father's will. We are powerless to accomplish God's will for our lives unless the Holy Spirit empowers us.


When we live a holy life and pray and ask the Holy Spirit to set our hearts on fire with Divine love and zeal he will set our hearts on fire so that we will go forth with passion to proclaim Jesus to the world. So let us pray to the Holy Spirit to set our hearts on fire with intense love for Jesus so that we may share the treasure of salvation with a world that is starving for the living water of the Spirit.
