PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"So do not worry and say, 'What are we to eat?' or 'What are we to drink?' or 'What are we to wear?' All these things the pagans seek. Your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given you besides. Do not worry about tomorrow; tomorrow will take care of itself. Sufficient for a day is its own evil." Mt 6:31-34

We all seek to be happy. We want to have peace and comfort. Peace and comfort are good things, but they can be placed above God and made into idols. What do we do when pain, emptiness and distress enter into life? If we are not following Jesus' words and commandments above our own plan, we will have great spiritual problems and distress. Sometimes people run to pleasures and distractions in order to numb the pain and emptiness they feel in life.

So what is the answer? "Seek first the Kingdom of God and all will be given to you." We must turn to Jesus in prayer when we are in distress and ask him to lift our desolation. We must then turn our self over to Jesus and say, "Lord you lead my day. What do you want me to do today? Lord you lead this prayer. Lord Jesus you lead everything in my life." When we do this we will experience Jesus leading us through all our problems into a peaceful journey (even in the midst suffering) of following him.

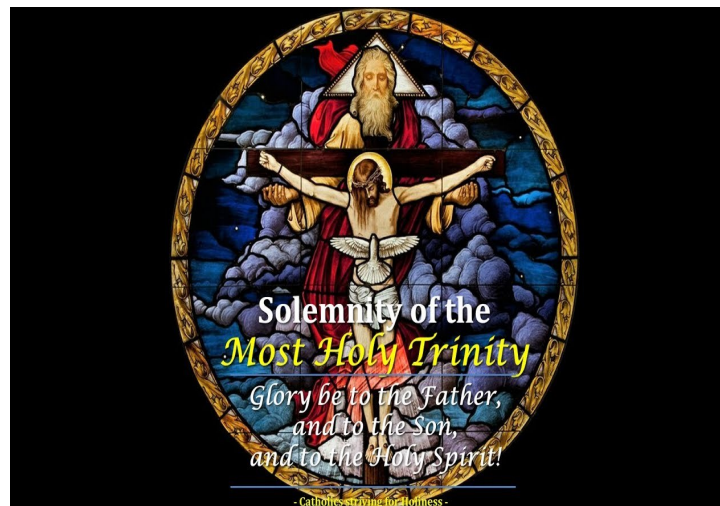
