#### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

*"The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. Mk 14:22-26*

Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi. Corpus Christi is Latin for "Body of Christ." With today's feast we celebrate our catholic belief that the Eucharist that we eat at mass is the real body and blood of Jesus Christ. In the communion host Jesus is really and truly present, body, blood, soul and divinity. When we eat the Eucharist it is no longer bread and it is not just a symbol that we eat but the real body and blood of Jesus.

Every Monday we have the Eucharist exposed for prayer and adoration at St. Mary's from 7 am to 8 pm. I want to invite everyone to spend some time praying in front of Jesus at Eucharistic Adoration. There is something very intimate and powerful that happens when we look at Jesus in the host during adoration and talk to him. It is like looking into the face of a dear friend as we speak heart to heart.

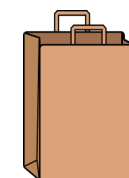
#### SUMMER RETREATS:
