PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples. As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love." Jn 15:4-10

God has made us to be connected to him and to each other in love. We are not islands. We need God and we need each other. We especially need God. When we disconnect from God through sin we start to get into spiritual trouble and our soul begins to starve. This is what Jesus is talking about in the scripture above. We are the branches and we dry up and wither if we do not remain in Jesus spiritually through daily prayer, scripture, weekly sacraments and holy living.

In fact this is why Jesus gave us the sacraments; so that we could reconnect with God the Father and live in him once again. We need God's love and grace in order to have spiritual life. Whenever we feel spiritual emptiness and lack of peace and joy, that is a sign that we are not fully connected to God who is our very source of life.

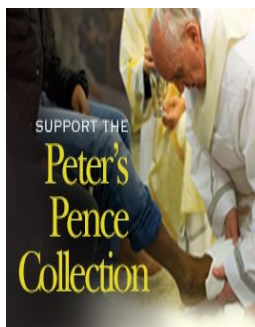
