Medication Documentation: Effective immediately, BGMPs will no longer accept over the counter (non-prescription medication) without documentation by a medical doctor/advanced practice nurse and the parent/guardian. The form was emailed home last week. All medications must be in the original containers with visible directions, and displaying the student's name. Request for administration of such medication must be consistent with directions for use on the package, container, etc. This is in accordance with Diocesan Policy and the Texas Catholic Conference Education Department.
