All incoming students are required to take this placement test, which consists of Math, Science, Language Arts, and Social Studies.

**Registration for 2018-19 School Year:** The registration fee for the 2018-2019 school year for current 6th and 7th graders is \$225.00. Registration for students new to Bishop Garriga Middle Preparatory School for the 2018-19 school year is ongoing.
