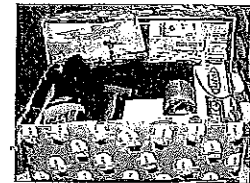


St. Anthony's and the Vietnamese Apostolate call to participation in the Rosary Congress in our Parish:
