Since I am unable at this moment to receive You sacramentally,

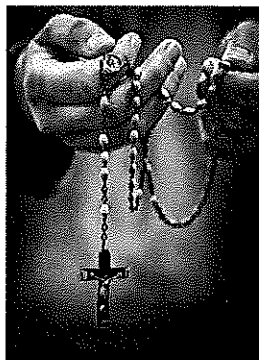
Come at least spiritually into my heart.

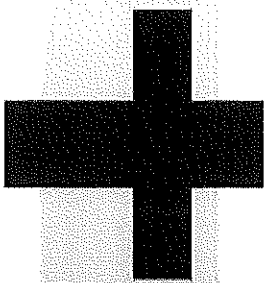

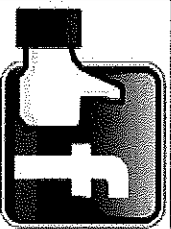
