And I desire to posses You within my soul.

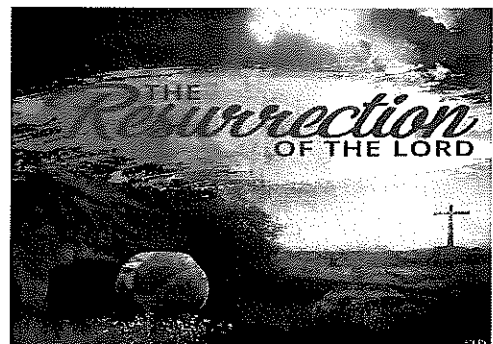
Since I am unable at this moment to receive You sacramentally, Come at least spiritually into my heart.

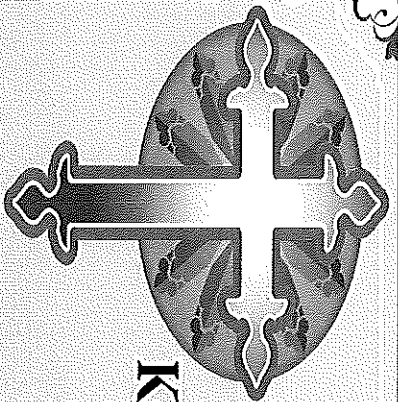
I embrace You as being already there,

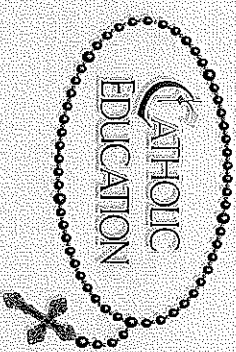
