St. Anthony of Padua Church will resume Mass with a congregation THIS WEEKEND, May 2nd & 3rd, with the following limitations:

Mass will be conducted at the regular times OUTDOORS with the altar set up under the portico of the Education Building until further notice. Please bring your own chair and umbrella (for shade). Please wear a mask and maintain 6 feet away from others. Family members within the same household may stand or sit closer than 6 feet from each other but maintain 6 feet away from other individuals or family groups. In case of rain, we will move Mass indoors but with only 75 individuals per Mass according to the State mandate of only 25% of the Church's occupancy.

Persons who are 65 years of age or older, have pre-existing conditions of heart disease, lung disease, obesity, diabetes, etc. should remain away from Mass attendance at this time. Please continue participating at home to the best of your ability through televised Masses, streaming via the internet or scripture reading and prayer.

Persons who are sick or have family members within their household or with whom there is contact are asked to stay home. It is imperative that we keep others safe and not spread illness.

Many other details will need to be worked out as we go along. Please graciously help us as we figure out how to accomplish the practice of our faith while caring for the health and safety of all.

The dispensation (removal of the obligation to attend Mass) remains in effect through the month of May. Persons who are uncomfortable for any reason with the idea of returning to public Mass at this time many continue to practice the faith through televised or streamed Masses on your devices at home or with scripture reading and prayer.

Persons who are unable to attend Mass but desire to receive communion are asked to make an appointment through the Church office at 361-972-2446.
