Important Class Information

This has been declared the Year of the Faith in the Diocese of Victoria and it has never been more important to remind parents that they are the first and best teachers of the faith for their children. The Church is here to assist you in this very important task.

Registration for the 2020/2021 Religious Education year has begun and will continue until Wednesday, September 30th. To register for the St. Anthony's Religious Education Program, families must have been registered parishioners of St. Anthony's as of December 31, 2019. Registration is required of all students in the program. There is a \$20 per child fee due at the time of registration. Registration forms can be downloaded from the parish website (www.stanthonypalacios.org) or picked up at the church office. All families that desire for this year's "CCD Year to Count" must register. Due to the pandemic, only First Communion and Confirmation will be attending weekly sessions in the Family Center. All other grade level will be attending 8 students at a time to ensure social distance requirements. Also, alternating weeks students are to complete home/virtual learning with his/her families with parental signatures indicating home/virtual learning occurred.
