The penitential season of the Church, Lent, began with Ash Wednesday on February 17th. It is a time for each of us to grow in our very important relationship to Christ. The Church asks us to prepare ourselves using our own initiatives, instead of the long fast and mortifications that was part of the observance of Lent in the past. There is a rule about fast and abstinence that apply on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. We are asked to abstain from meat on Fridays of Lent. Though they are not binding under the pain of sin, the rules are highly encouraged for a good reason. It is only in denying ourselves, with a specific purpose, that we are made conscious of our need to grow spiritually. To grow spiritually, we must seek to diminish and to remove sinful habits that harm our relationships to God and to one another. I think that each of us can find things in our lives that need improvement. Whatever our problems are that we need to resolve let us make the sacrifice and remind ourselves why we are making the sacrifice. At the same time we can pray to God that the sacrifice we make will help us root out a sinful habit. Prayer is the other necessary element in a good observance of Lent. We are focused on the cross during Lent, which was the greatest act of love that the world has ever witnessed. Let us make a special effort during this Penitential Season of Lent to maybe attend a Weekday Mass or the Stations of the Cross. Above all, let us schedule prayer into our daily life. May our Lord and his mother assist us as the family of God in growing ever closer to our ultimate goal....Jesus himself.
