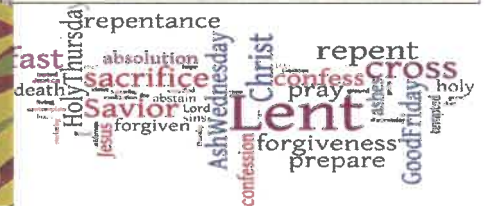

**HOLY WEEK AND THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM**

“The days of Jesus’ life-giving death and glorious resurrection are approaching, the hour he triumphed over Satan’s pride, the time we celebrate the great event of our redemption” (Preface of the Lord’s Passion II, Sacramentary). Thus the Church begins the one week of the year that we formally designate as “Holy.” Simple rituals can link the domestic church to parish church and Church universal. Enthroned Sunday’s palms where you pray, behind the family crucifix, even as part of front door decorations: “Christ reigns here,” they proclaim; “all are welcome!” During the first three days of Holy Week, ready Easter clothes, prepare festal foods, clean the house, beautify the yard. Late Holy Thursday afternoon, share Lent’s final meal before the Lord’s Supper Mass. Pitcher, bowl, and towel make a fitting centerpiece; perhaps conclude the meal by washing each other’s feet. On Good Friday, observe the paschal fast from food & entertainment too! Then come to Holy Saturday’s Vigil with mind clear, stomach empty, and heart full of “holy anticipation” that bursts into living flame when the new fire is kindled.

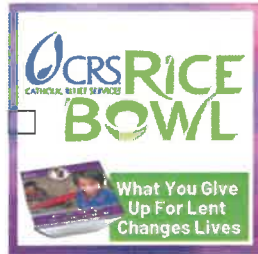

### What to do with Blessed Palms?

Many display the palms received at this liturgy behind a crucifix or religious picture in their home. For some, it is traditional to weave the palms into the form of a cross. An old Italian custom worth reviving is to present your palm branch to someone you have offended as a peace offering.

These palms have been blessed and are now Sacramental which should be treated with respect. They should never be thrown away. Blessed palms may only be buried or burned.

## Three days that changed the world



The liturgies from the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday through the evening of Easter Sunday are referred to as the "Triduum," meaning "three days." These are the days in which we are given the opportunity to share in the mystery and power of the Father's love as lived out in the suffering of Jesus, his Son. It is perhaps most helpful to think of these days, not as separate celebrations, but as one continuous remembrance in which we meet and follow Jesus.

### Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Last Supper

Lent ends at sundown today and the Paschal Triduum begins. The Gospel of John tells us that Jesus, while he was at supper, got up and washed the feet of the apostles. In the Middle East, where people's feet easily become dusty, this washing was an act of hospitality. Rich people usually had servants perform this service, so Peter was embarrassed and told Jesus not to do it. But Jesus warned Peter, "Unless I wash you, you can have no share with me." Then Jesus said, "I have given you an example. You should do for each other what I have done for you." During tonight's liturgy, we will have the opportunity to rededicate ourselves to ministerial service in a very meaningful and symbolic way. After celebrating Eucharist and sharing Communion, the consecrated elements will be carried out of church in a solemn procession; the night watch begins!

### Good Friday, Liturgy of the Passion

This day is part of something bigger than itself. The liturgies of Good Friday have no formal beginnings or endings, no greetings or dismissals. The services are all part of the single, three-day liturgy of the Triduum. The Eucharist is not celebrated. The Passion reading shows us how God's glory is seen in the suffering and death of Jesus. After the Passion reading, all are invited to venerate the Cross, and lastly, we receive Communion that was consecrated on Holy Thursday and held in repose for tonight's service.



### Holy Saturday, Easter Candlelight Vigil

At nightfall on Holy Saturday, the blessed Sabbath is over. The first day of the week begins. After the Sabbath, according to custom, the first work to be done is to make a fire and to kindle the evening lamp. That is what the Church does too. That is how the Easter Vigil begins. On this night, every member of the Church is asked to gather with the soon-to-be-baptized. We keep watch together. We settle down and re-tell our family stories. St. Augustine said that, on this night above all other nights, the Church keeps watch for the Lord and the Lord keeps watch over the Church!

**HOSANNA!**  
“Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest” (Matthew 21:9). With these words the Church enters the holiest of weeks, commemorating the passion, death, and resurrection of Christ. When the people of Jerusalem cried out with their “hosannas,” they were using an ancient Hebrew shout of acclamation that meant “Pray, save us.” The king to whom they were shouting eventually would save them, but in a way that would be far from what they expected. Salvation would come from the wood of the cross as Jesus hung there to bring freedom from sin and life through death, opening the gates of heaven for all who put their faith and trust in him.
