# All Saints School PBIS

## What is PBIS?

- PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports
- The purpose of the PBIS program is to establish and maintain consistent behavioral expectations across all learning environments to help students attain optimal success.

## What are the All Saints' PBIS expectations?

- We rock by being **RESPECTFUL**.
- We rock by being **RESPONSIBLE**.
- We rock by being **PROBLEM SOLVERS**.

## What does it look like to be **RESPECTFUL**, **RESPONSIBLE**, and **PROBLEM SOLVERS** at All Saints School?

- The All Saints' **Expectation Matrix** outlines what these actually look like across different school settings. There are also signs throughout the building to indicate expectations in different settings.
- These expectations are being taught to our students now by their teachers with refreshers that are provided daily throughout the school year.

## How are students acknowledged for showing the All Saints' PBIS expectations?

- A major part of any successful PBIS system is its acknowledgement system to help students get excited about the program and have recognition for good behavior.
- Students are recognized daily for showing positive behaviors by earning POGS (Positivity or Gratitude Stickers) through PBIS Rewards.
- Parents can download the PBIS Rewards Parent App to monitor their child's POGS
- Students can then "spend" their POGS at the Shamrock Shop (open on Fridays during lunch) or at their teacher's classroom store. Items and POGS amounts for the stores will be posted in your child's classroom.

## What happens when students don't show the All Saints' PBIS expectations?

- When students fail to meet expectations, we must teach the student the correct behavior and provide corrective consequences. For minor referrals, Grades K-3 will focus on natural consequences and will notify the parents. Grades 4-8 will continue to use the point card. For major referrals, where students are sent to the office, the parents will be notified, and it will be documented in PBIS Rewards. It will also be reflective on the point card.
- A Think Sheet could also be used to help students reflect about their behavior. Any student that comes to the office for a major referral will fill out a Think Sheet.
