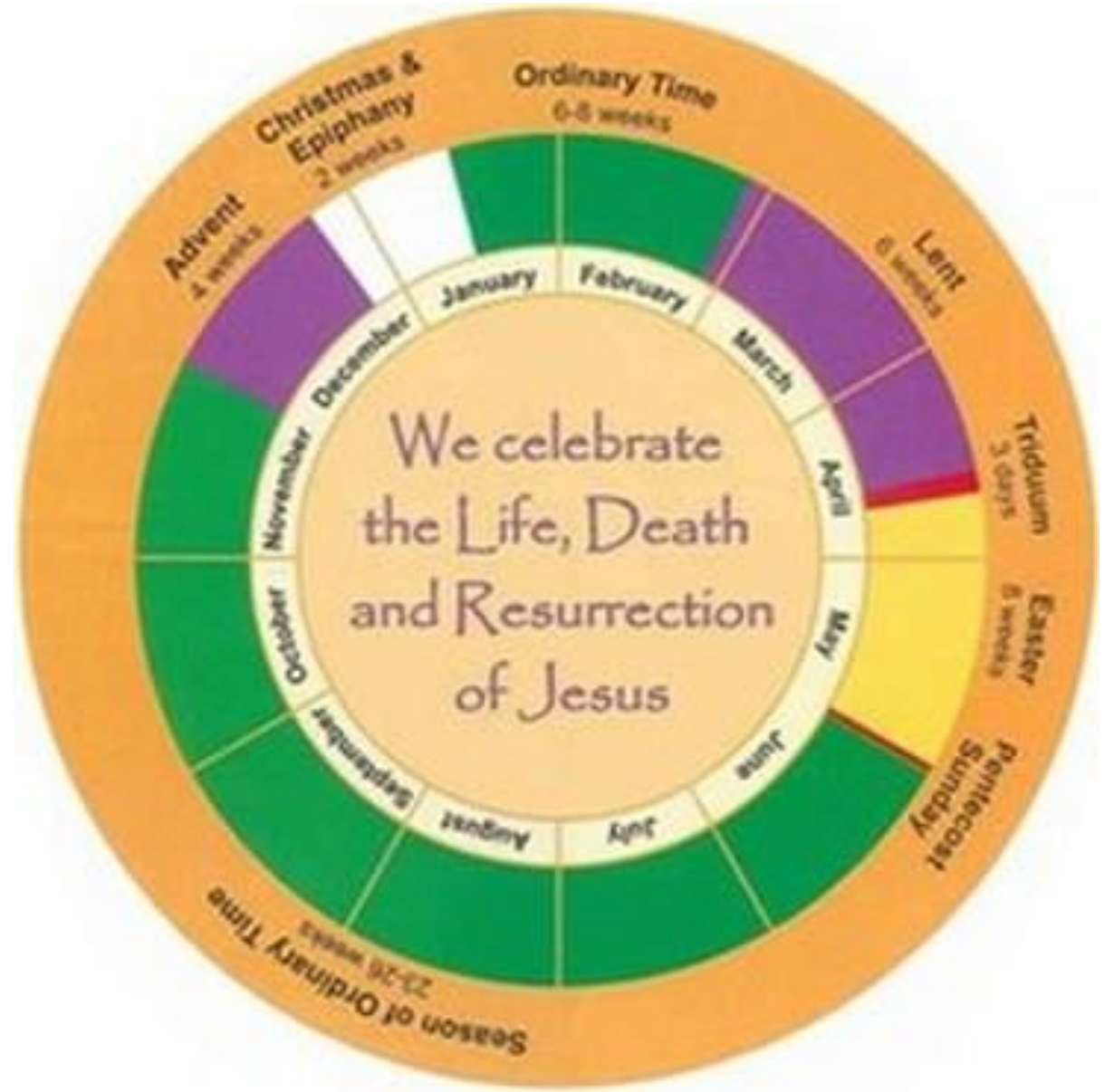
Know that I am thinking of, and praying for, you. I hope to see you all again soon... 😊
