

Week by week FAMILY Guide – 2nd Year Sacrament Preparation

In Order to receive credit for this year, each family must commit to:

- Weekly Sunday Mass – Virtual or in-person
- One Call a month from your catechist (please take a picture of your child’s work and send it to your catechist for credit)
- One parent zoom class per month with Nancy
- Complete One lesson per week (in person or on-line)- You have the freedom to complete each class on a day and time that works for your family. Our suggestion is to pick the same day and time each week. (take a picture of your child’s work and send it to your catechist for credit)
- Help your child/ren memorize the basic prayers – 2nd graders need to know: Sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Grace before meals and Act of Contrition. (The Catholic Children’s Bible has them listed beginning 1990.)
