The format for grades 1, 3-5 is “class attached to Mass.” It will allow families to make the connection from classroom catechesis to Mass. We will meet on Sundays at the 9:30am Mass and 11:30am Mass followed by classroom instruction. We will be continuing with our *Christ In Us* curriculum which provides a robust digital portal for families. This digital portal can be accessed at home and in the classroom; enhancing our family faith formation focus.

We will also, once again offer our Family Faith Days, which are Living Rosary, Family Advent Day, Family Lenten Day and Children’s Way of the Cross.

### Schedule of Classes

The families did such a great job in completing the e-books at home last year that we would like to keep families involved in their children’s faith formation. Preparation begins with the “first catechists,” a child’s parents. Therefore, we are asking that the Lessons be read at home with the family the week prior. Students should be ready to discuss the lessons in class. Catechists will reinforce what is being read at home.
