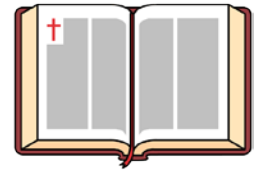

To be eligible for the voucher, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 60 years of age or older**
- Live at or below 185% of the federal poverty guidelines (for one person they can earn \$1800 a month)**
- They must reside in one of the following counties: Archer, Baylor, Clay, Foard, Haskell, Jack, Knox, Montague, Wichita, Wilbarger or Young counties.**
