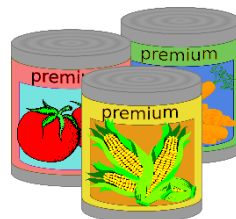

RELICS OF ST. THERESE OF LISIEUX: This weekend we are honored to have relics of St. Therese of Lisieux present for all Masses and for veneration following Mass.

SAINT THERESE OF LISIEUX

Therese Martin was the last of nine children born to Louis and Zelig Martin on January 2, 1873, in Alencon, France. Her mother died when she was 4 years old. At the age of 14, on Christmas Eve in 1886, Therese had a conversion that transformed her life. At 15, she entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux to give her whole life to God. Living a hidden, simple life of prayer, she was gifted with great intimacy with God. After a long struggle with tuberculosis, she died on September 30, 1897, at the age of 24. Her last words were the story of her life: "My God, I love You!" The world came to know Therese through her autobiography, "Story of a Soul". She lived each day with an unshakable confidence in God's love. "What matters in life," she wrote, "is not great deeds, but great love." She loved flowers and saw herself as the "little flower of Jesus," who gave glory to God by just being her beautiful little self among all the other flowers in God's garden. Because of this beautiful analogy, the title "little flower" remained with St. Therese. Her inspiration and powerful presence from heaven touched many people very quickly. She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925. "My mission - to make God loved - will begin after my death," she said. "I will spend my heaven doing good on earth. I will let fall a shower of roses."

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

Thank you for attending Christ the King, St Jude Thaddeus, and St Paul parish families. While we gather together to worship under the protective hand of our Heavenly Father, it is important that we recognize the brokenness of our society and potential harm that some wish to inflict on others. Below are instructions for a coordinated response that can keep your family safe if such a horrific incident should occur.

- Run - Getting away from violence is the priority. Leave your things behind and run away. Warn others and call 911 when it is safe to do so. Describe each perpetrator and their location if possible to responding police officers.
- Hide - If you can't get away safely, find a place to hide. Stay out of the assailants view and stay very quiet. Silence your electronic devices. Lock and block doors, close blinds and turn off lights if you are able to hide in a room.
- Fight - As a last resort, defend yourself if you are in imminent danger. Commit to your actions and be aggressive in order to stop the violence.
