DIocese OF FORT WORTH 50TH ANNIVERSARY

ILLUSTRATED BOOK: Over the past two years, North Texas Catholic reporter and local author Jerry Circelli and the Diocesan Communications Office have been collaborating on the publication of a history book to celebrate the impending 50th Anniversary of the establishment of the Catholic Diocese of Fort Worth by Blessed Pope Paul VI. The book will convey the history of the Church in the 28-county part of North Texas that makes up the Diocese of Fort Worth. This book has been conceived and designed with all our parishioners in mind. The draft pages for our three parishes; St. Paul, St. Jude Thaddeus, and Christ the King, from the illustrated book are available on the parish website in the news section. PENTECOST: BE A DISCIPLE OF CHRIST

It is amazing to consider how dramatically life changed for Jesus' disciples and other followers and for witnesses of his resurrection. Pentecost brought about huge transformations: fear into courage, disbelief into belief, apathy into zeal, and maintenance into mission! Traveling outward into the world of the unfamiliar and sometimes hostile, the disciples set sail to proclaim the Good News to new people and new places. Their lives gave witness to many things, but one in particular became a huge game changer.

A true and real encounter with the Trinitarian God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - dramatically changed everything, including how they perceived God (in all His revealed fullness), one another, themselves, and creation. They finally understood that everything was imbued with God's life and love. Assured of the help and advocacy of the Holy Spirit and inspired by zealous folks like St. Paul, these early vibrant Christian communities flourished and embraced their new life.

All of the fruits of the Spirit can lead to unity, and it is in unity that we, the contemporary disciples of Christ, find strength. Dissentions, factions, hatred, and rivalry have no place in any community let alone one that calls itself Christian. In fact, they will swiftly lead to our demise. We may not agree with where the world and Church are going, but we are asked to preach the Good News to new people and to help them understand what is needed in order to nurture healthy, properly ordered relationships. The first disciples really did not know where they were going. They just went. Our time is not so dissimilar. With the Holy Spirit as our guide, we can become who we need to be and who God wants us to be, and we can tend to the needs of all of our brothers and sisters as is their right and dignity. -LPI
