18TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

Today's Gospel continues our five-week selection from the sixth chapter of John, where Jesus is portrayed as the "Bread of Life." Jesus has just fed a crowd of hungry people with a few loaves of bread and some fish, but the people misunderstand the sign, focusing only on getting something to eat. Jesus wants them to look beyond the earthly food, to "the food that endures for eternal life."

A popular Eucharistic song of some years ago urged us to "look beyond" the physical signs of bread and wine we receive at Eucharist, to our Lord and Savior who is present there. What are our expectations as we gather each week for Mass? We may find fault with the music, the homily, the behavior of the neighbor's children - but our faith tells us that this is the place we are to be fed and healed and forgiven. -Franciscan Media

ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY:

The Assumption is the oldest feast day of Our Blessed Mother. All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.

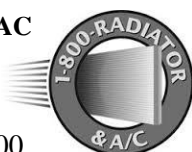
