REFUGEE BORDER UPDATE:

Over the last several weeks, Catholic Charities Fort Worth (CCFW) has been humbled and grateful to serve unaccompanied children in the wake of families being separated at the border, as we have done since 2014. Our agency is proud to be supported by so many volunteers, staff, and donors; who have stepped up to aid these children in such a huge way. CCFW has received over 75 inquiries for families interested in fostering - which we very much need -not just for unaccompanied children but for our refugee children. We have received close to 1,000 hygiene kits that will be used to welcome unaccompanied children that we serve currently and in the future. We have been able to send a staff person to support the Humanitarian Respite Center in McAllen, TX, which is operated by Catholic Charities Rio Grande Valley. We could not say yes to serving without the support of our volunteers and donors. Our staff member, who is serving the Humanitarian Respite Center in McAllen, is working hard to help refugees from Honduras, Guatemala, and El Salvador. He reports that most families are in McAllen for a short time before they continue on their journey to be with extended family. At the Humanitarian Respite Center, refugees are given a hot meal, a new set of clothes, minor medical care, and a shower. When they have finished this process, a lawyer is able to advise them about their rights and their upcoming court case. There simply isn't a more tangible way to show Christ's compassion than by feeding the hungry, clothing the travel worn, and providing shelter to the homeless For more information please visit our blog.
