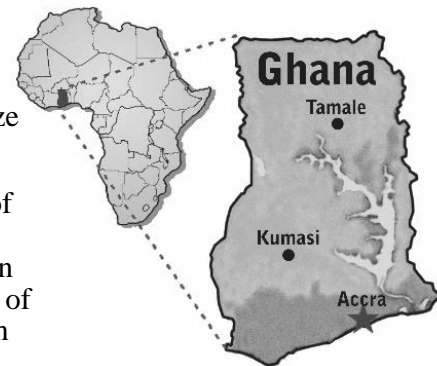

Each year in the Diocese of Ft. Worth parishes are asked to host a speaker from a Mission Diocese, Organization or an Order involved in overseas missions. This provides opportunities for prayer and financial support of the poorest people throughout the world. On **October 27th and 28th** Fr. Peter O. Ware will celebrate Masses at all three parishes and speak on behalf of the mission church in the Archdiocese of Kumasi, Ghana.



Ghana is a small country 1/5 the size of Texas.

The Archdiocese of Kumasi has a Catholic population of 378,047, 19.4% of the total population of 1,946,098.

MISSION WORK IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF KUMASI, GHANA

The Archdiocese of Kumasi, in Ghana (West Africa), was established by missionaries in 1950. Since that time, there has been tremendous growth in the Church in Ghana. Currently there are 16 dioceses and 4 archdioceses.

The Archdiocese of Kumasi works to Evangelize through projects that improve the health and well-being of people by the building and upgrading of rural health clinics, the care for street children and by providing accessible, clean drinking water through the construction of new wells, especially on school grounds and in rural communities. There are still many areas where people walk a great distance for clean drinking water. Your support also assists in the construction of new schools for both education and spiritual growth.

Most Rev. Gabriel J. Anokye of the Archbishop of Kumasi, expresses his gratitude to the Church in America and acknowledges that the generosity of American Catholics has immensely improved the living conditions of many in Kumasi and has aided the growth of the Church in Africa as a whole.

We thank you very much in anticipation of your generous financial support and for the hospitality offered to our missionary representative visiting your parish community. Your parish family will be remembered in Masses and prayers offered by the priests, deacons, religious, and missionaries serving in the Archdiocese of Kumasi, Ghana. 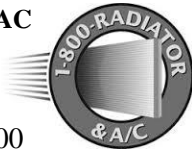
