One day, a group of hunters discovered St. Blaise and seized him. While in prison, he miraculously cured a small boy who was choking to death on a fishbone lodged in his throat. Eventually, St. Blaise was condemned for upholding his Christian faith and was tortured and beheaded. By the sixth century, St. Blaise's intercession was invoked for diseases of the throat.

4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Christian writer, Frederick Buechner, once wrote that there is no record of anyone inviting a prophet home to dinner more than once. Buechner's quip was his way to define the role of the biblical prophets - certainly they were controversial figures!

Today we hear God choose Jeremiah for that role. God warns the prophet that his message to the kings and priests of Judah will be so challenging that he will meet with opposition. Biblical prophets were not out to make enemies, but felt impelled to speak the truth - God's truth - with love. It just so happened that their message was often "tough love."

Jesus in our Gospel today, is a prophet visiting his hometown. He anticipates resistance, stating clearly that no prophet is ever accepted in his native place. His words prove true as the people rise up to throw Jesus over a cliff!

Few of us are called to be prophets, but I suspect we can identify some contemporary figures who fit that role. Pope John Paul II often challenged the Church and the secular world with his teaching of the Gospel on a variety of subjects from abortion to capital punishment to social justice.

How do we accept the prophetic message we hear proclaimed each Sunday? And would we invite the bearer of that message home for Sunday dinner?

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION:

"Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, it is not pompous." 1 Corinthians 13:4

Do you get jealous? Do you focus more on the things that other people have than on the gifts that God has given to you? Are you pompous? Do you acquire more possessions to impress others? At times we are all guilty of these things. Pray for more humility. Pray to become less "self-centered" and become more "God-centered".
