6th SUNDAY OF EASTER:

Today's Scripture selections continue our Easter instructions for the newly-baptized. The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles reflects how Christian witness might be received—persecution was a real threat for the Church in Jerusalem.

The First Letter of Peter seems to reflect a similar harsh reality. Peter urges Christians to approach others ready to explain who we are, but to do so with “gentleness and reverence.”

That reminds me of the advice that St. Francis of Assisi gave his brothers who were thinking of being missionaries. He told them to “avoid quarrels or disputes,” and to “be subject to every human creature for God's sake.” Francis was quoting from the First Letter of Peter. The letter goes on to encourage those fearful of persecution to remember that Christ also suffered persecution.

In the Gospel, Jesus himself assures us that we will not be alone; the Holy Spirit will be present with us to support and guide us.

SAFETY PRACTICES AND PROTOCOLS FOR OUR PARISHES: *If you are not well or are sick, please stay home and continue to join us virtually through the livestream of the Mass.* Your Sunday obligation remains lifted throughout this pandemic.

If you are not comfortable being inside the church for Mass, you can attend Mass via livestream in your vehicle. After Mass, we will distribute the Eucharist for those who are attending Mass in their vehicles. *Ushers will escort Father Khoi and give proper instructions and signals for communion in the parking lot so please listen and follow them.* Each vehicle's family unit or individual can exit one by one, while maintaining proper social distance, to receive the Body of Christ.

Our pews will be properly sanitized before and after each Mass. Each pew will be marked and spaced apart for social distancing. *Family members can sit together, but individuals MUST maintain the 6-foot social distance rule. Each person is required to wear a face covering or mask* when entering the church and throughout the Mass.

- Please be mindful of absolutely **NO holding hands** at the "Our Father" prayer. The Sign of Peace is suspended.
- At communion time, the *ushers will slowly direct each pew* to receive the Body of Christ; so please be patient and follow proper instructions.
- Please *receive the Eucharist on your hands if possible*, mindful of keeping them clean as the throne of the King of the Universe as well as being aware of the Eucharistic particles that may be left behind.
- There will be *no passing of the basket at the offertory*. Instead, there will be a secured box at the back of the church for your stewardship offerings.
- Please do not rush out of church at the end of Mass and create unnecessary congestion. *Ushers will slowly dismiss the congregation* – row by row, from the back to the front – when Mass is finished; please be patient and follow their instructions.

We ask for your understanding as we put into practice these proper protocols for the safety of all. *There will be no congregating in the foyer or inside areas of the church before or after Mass.* You can use the outdoor areas, with proper social distancing, if needed. Please be mindful to follow instructions to slowly enter and exit the church, in order to keep proper social distance between each individual or family unit.

PENTECOST SUNDAY: This year Pentecost Sunday will have even more significance than normal. On Saturday May 30th, the sacraments of Initiation for Elects will be celebrated at the 5pm mass. On Sunday May 31st, the sacrament of confirmation will be celebrated at the 11am mass. Due to the current pandemic, these sacraments will be celebrated together at the 11a mass on Pentecost Sunday, May 31st, by Father Khoi.
