In parish ministry before seminary, I taught religious education and Confirmation preparation, trained lay readers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, and instituted acolytes, and worked in youth ministry for many years.

All that said, I look forward to focusing the next six months on getting to know as many of my precious parishioners as I can. I will block out time in my schedule each week to devote to meeting you.

As your priest and shepherd, I look forward to celebrating the sacraments and rituals of Holy Mother Church with you, preaching, and instructing you in the whole of the Gospel and Church doctrine, and spiritually nourishing you in your prayer and devotion to lead you into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ, the Eternal Word of God.

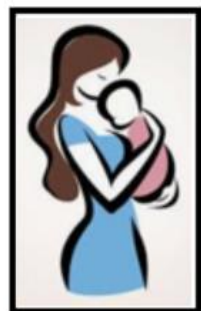

Sufficiency—enoughness—is the middle way between scarcity and exploitative wealth. As Gandhi put it, the world has enough for everyone's need, but not enough for everyone's greed.
