- I. Capital Campaign
  - a. We need to have \$140,000 in the bank before we can start the renovations. Council agreed to set Summer 2017, as our goal for the first \$140,000.
  - b. Janel Dolan and Greg Leonard will do talks from the Pulpit the weekends of April 9 /10, and April 16/17.  
Envelopes will go out with pledge cards April 22.  
2<sup>nd</sup> letter will go out May 20.
- II. Repairs and Updates around the Church
  - a. Ceiling – the man is working on preparing the beams. It may be another week before the staining and varnishing is completed.
  - b. Church lighting will be replaced with LED lights. They should be more cost effective and give better light.

  - a. Gillis Carrol is heading, with help from many others. Dates are June 13 – 17, 5:45-8:00.
  - b. Theme is High Seas Adventure – we did in 2012.
  - c. People are in place for the major areas.

- V. Parish Fall Festival
  - a. Bill McGuire reported to Fr. Khoi the Carmen and Tina were interested in heading up the Fall Festival. Susan and Margie will be available to help them.
  - b. Greg Leonard asked to have someone shadow him (food ordering, kitchen prep, etc.) for the Festival. Committee felt Jerry Coker would be a good candidate.
  - c. Fr. Khoi asked the Committee about repairing the phone line to the Parish Hall. We lost a lot of phone in orders this past year due to the line not working. Council decided to use a TracPhone and publish the number on the tickets and all advertising. We felt this would be more cost effective for now.
  - d. Allan Sandquist advised Greg Leonard that those who work in the kitchen during the Festival needed a Food Handler's License. He reported the Knights have 5 to 6 people

identified on site that have a license during their events. Committee agreed Greg Leonard, Jerry Coker, Steve Booker, Tom Peoples, and Linda Gibson would get their Food Handler's and have documentation on site during the Festival.
