12th Sunday in Ordinary Time-Ps 145 (144): 15

The eyes of all look **to you, Lord**
and you give them their food in **due** season.

13th Sunday in Ordinary Time-Cf. Ps 103 (102): 1

Bless the Lord, **O my Soul**,
and all within me, his ho**ly** name.

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time-Ps 34(33):9

Taste and see that the Lord **is good**;
blessed the man who seeks re**fu**ge **in him**.

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time- cf. Ps 84 (83):4-5

The sparrow finds a home, **+**
and the swallow a nest **for her young**:
by your altars, O Lord of hosts, my King and **my God**.
Blessed are they who dwell **in your house**,
for ever singing **your praise**.

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 111 (110):4-5

The Lord, the gracious, the merciful, **+**
has made a memorial **of his wonders**;
he gives food to those **who fear him**.

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 103 (102):2

Bless the Lord, O my **soul**,
and never forget **all his benefits**.

18th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Wis 16: 20

You have given us, O Lord, **bread** **from heaven**,
endowed with all delights and sweetness in ev**ery** taste.

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time-Ps 147: 12. 14

O Jerusalem, glorify **the Lord**,
who gives you your fill of **fi**nest wheat.

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 130 (129): 7

With the Lord there **is** mercy;
in him is plentiful **re**demption.

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 104 (103): 13-15

you bring forth bread **from** **the** earth

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 31 (30): 20

How great is **the** goodness, Lord,

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 42 (41): 2-3

so my soul is yearning for you, my God;
my soul is thirsting for God, the living God.

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 36 (35): 8

How precious is your mercy, O God!
The Children of man seek shelter in the shadow of your wings.

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 119 (118): 4-5

You have laid down your precepts to be carefully kept;
may my ways be firm in keeping your statutes.

26th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 119 (118): 49-50

Remember your word to your servant, O Lord, **+**
by which you have given me hope.
This is my comfort when I am brought low.

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Lam 3: 25

The Lord is good to those who hope in him,
to the soul that seeks him.

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 34 (33): 11

The rich suffer want and go hungry,
but those who seek the Lord lack no blessing.

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 33 (32): 18-19

Behold, the eyes of the Lord +
 are on those who fear him,
 who hope in his merciful love,
 to rescue their souls from death,
 to keep them alive in famine.

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 20 (19): 6

We will ring out our joy at your saving help
 and exult in the name of our God.

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 16 (15): 11

You will show me the path of life,
 the fullness of joy in your presence, O Lord.

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time- Cf. Ps 23 (22): 1-2

The Lord is my Shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. +
 Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose,

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time- Ps 73 (72): 28

To be near God is my happiness,
