ST. AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY, BISHOP – Feast day Monday, May 27th – In 596, Pope Gregory the Great sent Augustine, prior of St. Andrew’s monastery in Rome, and about 40 monks to evangelize England. Their work was difficult, but patiently they labored, heeding the advice of Pope Gregory whose enlightened principles counseled them to make adaptations. He encouraged them to use their temples rather than destroy them; to adapt pagan celebrations to Christian feasts, and to use local customs when possible. Augustine established a Benedictine monastery at Canterbury. As the first Archbishop of Canterbury and the “Apostle of the English,” he continued to spread Christianity in Britain until his death.

ST. JUSTIN, MARTYR – Feast day Saturday, June 1st -Justin, a Samaritan, was called “The Philosopher.” A convert to Christianity, this layman used his knowledge of philosophy to explain Christian doctrine. Justin pursued truth, investigated many philosophies of his day, but found none of them convincing or satisfying. Therefore, his quest for truth led him to Christianity. He admired the strength shown by the martyrs when faced with death, and he wrote later “I both prayed and strove with all my might to be found a Christian.” After his conversion he devoted himself to the defense of the Christian faith.
