Running to one hundred pages, with our Charter for the Diocese, our Catechesis and Consultation, and telling the story of our diocese in pictures, we would like to think they contain the words of the Holy Spirit Himself, speaking through the People of God. In that sense we can regard them as authoritative for our diocese and a reference point for us to turn to as a touchstone of the Lord's own plan for our way into the future.
