FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL CHURCH VOLUNTEERS WITH PVG CERTIFICATES

The Diocesan Safeguarding Advisory Group has recommended that *all* volunteers doing regulated work with children and vulnerable adults *or both*, *should* do the Level 1 training by the end of 2017 and, with the agreement of Bishop John, this will now be implemented as diocesan policy. The next training sessions will take place in: St. Patrick's, Greenock on **Wednesday 27th September** at 7pm. St. Fergus', Paisley on **Thursday 2nd November** at 2pm. St. Colm's, Kilmacolm on **Tuesday 7th November** at 7pm. St. Conval's, Linwood on **Tuesday 14th November** at 7pm. There will be limited space at each session, therefore volunteers should register up to one week before the date of the training session.

October Visit of the Fatima Pilgrim Statue to Paisley Diocese

The Fatima Pilgrim Statue, touring Scotland in this centenary year of the apparitions of Our Lady, will be in Paisley Diocese from 7th – 16th October. We encourage you to make a personal pilgrimage with your petitions to Our Lady in this time of special grace. On the Feast of the Holy Rosary, Sat 7th October, 4.30pm, Bishop John will welcome the Pilgrim Statue to St. Mirin's Cathedral in a Welcome Service with Holy Rosary, followed by the Vigil Mass celebrated by Canon Oliver at 5.30pm. Bishop John will celebrate mass at 12noon on Sunday 8th October in the Cathedral. The Statue will remain in the Cathedral for special services and personal devotion through the following week. It will be taken to Christ the King, Howwood for the last Fatima Vigil of the Centenary Year, Thursday 12th October, and remain for the weekend. Because we are receiving the pilgrim statue, the format will vary slightly: 7.30 solemn welcome and crowning of the statue; rosary, mass, exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and benediction. As Always, the hall will be open from 7-7.30pm and again after benediction. Its last stop will be in the Chapel of the Little Sisters' Holy Rosary Residence on Monday 16th October.
