## IN REMEMBRANCE

At every Mass, we pray for our deceased relatives and friends but, in keeping with Catholic tradition, November is a month specifically dedicated to praying for the Holy Souls. On or near the Feast of All Souls, a special *Mass of Remembrance* is celebrated in our parish for all our deceased loved ones. As a Parish community, we now hope to commemorate our deceased parishioners in two very special and everlasting ways:

**Firstly**, we think it fitting to establish a dedicated *Altar of Remembrance* on which a *Parish Memorial Book* will be placed as a perpetual reminder of all our deceased parishioners.

**Secondly**, we also wish to provide families and friends of our deceased parishioners - and benefactors - the option to dedicate individual/family *Memorial Plaques* which will be permanently mounted on the walls around this Altar.

A "*Memorial Plaque*" brochure, available after Mass in the sacristy, contains more details of these plans. We hope you share our view that these plans provide a befitting memorial to our deceased loved ones and that you will support our endeavours.

**Rosary on the Coast in Paisley Diocese, Sunday 29 April:** Following on from the national Rosary events in Poland and Ireland and soon to take place in the USA, the Rosary on the Coast of the British Isles is taking place on Sunday 29 April. Bishop John will lead a Rosary on the Coast service in St. Mary's Church, Greenock at 3.00pm on that day. Other groups are gathering in the diocese to which everyone is encouraged to attend. This event is for Faith, Life and Peace. It is about faith as conversion, about atonement for the scourge of abortion, and about the peace that Jesus wills to restore to our society.
