**The next Cenacolo Prayer Group meeting:** this will take place in **St Mary's Greenock** on **Tuesday 7th August at 7 p.m.** The group meets ever first and third Tuesday in a month to pray before the Blessed Sacrament for the needs of those who suffer from alcohol and drug dependency. The prayer session is open to all who would wish to help others by invoking the aid of the Lord for those who suffer from the misuse of alcohol or drugs. Entry to the church is by the Houston Street door on these evenings. Cenacolo is a movement set up by an Italian nun, Sister Elvira, to support young men and woman who suffered addiction. The 54 plus communities worldwide rely purely on providence and prayer for their everyday needs. Unlike a rehabilitation unit there are no psychiatrists, psychotherapists or medication. Life in the community is simple and centred on work and prayer.
