### 'Priest School'

Sunday 19th April at 9pm  
BBC Scotland

A documentary 'Priest School' which will be broadcast on the new BBC Scotland channel on Sunday 19th April at 9pm.

Last year, the Bishops' Conference agreed to grant the TV production company Solus Productions access to the Pontifical Scots College in order to produce an hour-long documentary. The programme will give Scottish audiences an insight into the formation and faith journey of the class of 2018/2019, with special focus on five young seminarians at differing stages in their studies.

Anything you can do to promote this documentary among your family and friends will be helpful in persuading broadcasters that programmes with Catholic themes or content can attract sizeable audiences. The more people who watch the greater the chance that further programmes will be produced to promote Catholic themes—Enjoy!

### HOLY WEEK CELEBRATIONS

The Holy Week Masses and Services will be celebrated **PRIVATELY** in the church. I encourage you on those days, in so far as you can, to pray with me these special liturgies that are central to the Catholic faith in this Great Holy Week. I will include special prayers around the Coronavirus, praying for the safety and wellbeing of all. Palms will be blessed on Palm Sunday at Mass and will be available for parishioners at a later date, when it is safe to distribute them. I will celebrate the liturgies on the following days:

**Palm Sunday at 11am.**  
**Holy Thursday at 7pm.**  
**Good Friday at 3pm.**  
**Easter Vigil at 8.30pm.**  
**Easter Sunday at 11am.**

I will remember you and your loved ones at all of the above liturgies.

### DIOCESAN DIRECTIVE

Baptisms are deferred (except in cases of danger of death).

*Catechumens and Candidates: arrangements for reception into the full communion with the Church will be made at a later date.*

**Weddings** are deferred.

**First Holy Communion & Confirmation:**

**Please note that the scheduled dates for these Sacraments have been postponed due to the impact of Covid 19.** Amended dates will be provided when possible.

**Funerals: Funeral rites will be held at the place of committal** since Places of Public Worship are closed.

**Arrangements with families will be made by 'phone in place of home visits.** Given the importance of health and safety during this pandemic, **only close family members are permitted to attend an interment or cremation** Some families mourning their loved ones may be unable to attend the funeral due to them being in self-isolation. **Please be assured that a Memorial Mass will be offered at a later date.**
