<p>St. Vincent dePaul Center & Thrift Store</p>	<p>The St. Edward Conference of St. Vincent de Paul has joined with the Conferences of St. Francis, St. Leonard and Blessed Sacrament Parishes in the operation of a non-profit multipurpose outreach Center which is located in Newark.</p> <p><u>Food Pantry</u> The pantry is the second busiest of the 19 food pantries located in Licking County. Each month over 220 families are served. We are a run entirely by volunteers. Volunteers are needed to help stock the pantry, assist the families in shopping for their food, drive families home from the pantry and to pick up food at the Heath Kroger's. The stockers work on either Monday or Thursday from 1:00 - 3:00 PM. The servers and drivers work on Tuesday from 6:30 - 8:00 PM or on Saturday from 9:00 - 11:00 AM. The Kroger pick-up takes place on Thursdays at 11:00 AM. Volunteers are asked to commit to one volunteer session each month (a commitment of 2 hours each month). Some volunteers work more than one volunteer session. All volunteers are trained for their specific jobs.</p> <p><u>Thrift Store</u> The Thrift Store is vital to the financial health of the ministry. The help of volunteers allow more of the money earned to go directly to our projects. Volunteers help price items, stock the shelves, work the cash register and assist customers.
