Coronavirus Guidelines

In view of the current health crisis, we are especially concerned about your safety and physical well-being. Please comply with the following guidelines during your stay.

- Please notify one of our staff if you are feeling ill.
- Please leave six feet between you and your nearest neighbor whenever you are indoors. Use your mask in any situation where you will be less than six feet away from your neighbor.
- Fr. Mark and Fr. Lino will designate your area for individual meetings.

IN THE VILLA

After using the common area of your villa, please disinfect the area you have used with the disinfectant or wipes provided in the common area. Wash hands after disinfecting.

IN THE CHAPEL

When using the chapel:

- Please sit only in chairs that have the Our Lady of Perpetual Help logo on the back. This will ensure that you are seated at least six feet from your nearest neighbor.
- Please wear mask until Communion.
- When receiving Communion:
 - Beginning on Mary side of chapel, approach the priest one at a time; the next communicant should not approach the priest until the previous communicant has returned to their seat.
 - Please inform the celebrant ahead of time if you would like to receive Communion on the tongue.
 - If any physical contact occurs between the communicant and the priest, the priest will use hand sanitizer and let his hands dry momentarily before resuming distribution of communion.
- Before leaving chapel, disinfect your chair and the one directly in front of you with the disinfectant or wipes provided in the entryway of the chapel, and wash your hands after disinfecting.
- For private prayer in chapel, please wear a mask until arriving at your seat; you may remove your mask if you are more than six feet away from your nearest neighbor.
- Please exercise caution around improvement projects in the retreat grounds and the area surrounding the chapel.

Coronavirus Guidelines

IN THE DINING ROOM

When eating lunch or dinner:

- Please sit one retreatant per table unless you are from the same household. If there is not sufficient room to fit one per table, two may sit at one of the larger tables, which are six feet in diameter.
- Meals will be served by our staff in the window area of the kitchen. Please wait to approach to get your meal until the previous retreatant has returned to their seat.
- Beverages will be set on beverage counter. Please wait to approach and get your beverage until the previous retreatant has returned to their seat.
- Please place used dishes in cart placed outside of the sink area after the meal. Please wait to approach until the previous retreatant has walked away from the cart.
