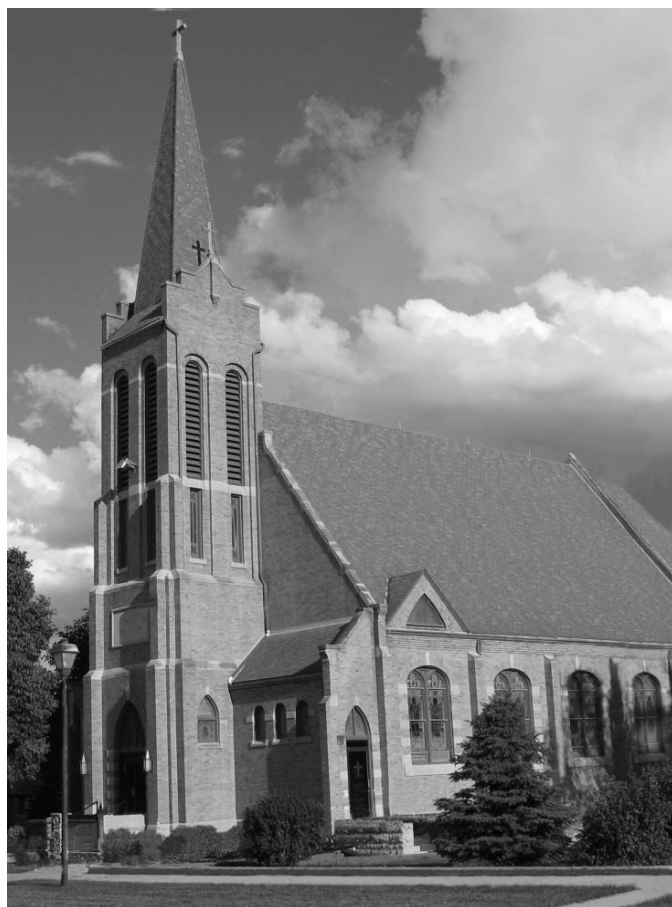

Are you a registered member of the parish? You know you are a registered member of the parish if you receive:

1. Contribution envelope packets.
2. A subscription to The Catholic Globe [the Diocesan newspaper].
3. The annual DAA appeal letter.
4. Regular mailings from the parish.

Registered members are expected to contribute to the parish through time, talent, and treasure in addition to paying their Globe subscription and contributing to DAA. Often, young parishioners leave their family home, get married, and consider themselves to be registered members of the parish as they were registered under their parents' names. However, when young parishioners leave their family home, particularly after college, get married and/or begin employment, they become unregistered members of the parish in which territory they live. Simply living within the territory of a parish does not make a person a registered member of the parish. Persons wishing to register in the parish need to complete the registration process. Persons Wishing To Join The Catholic Church, whether baptized in another faith or unbaptized and over the age of seven (7), may contact the pastor at any time of the year to begin the process known as RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)/RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children). Preparation classes normally begin in September.
